

Techsploration and Irving Shipbuilding are pleased to launch four (4)  $\times$  \$3,500 scholarships to students entering their first or second year of any trades, business, or technology program at NSCC.

## Who is eligible to apply?

- 1. All Techsploration school graduates who self-identify as women, and may also identify as Mi'kmaw or Indigenous people, or African Nova Scotians. Preference goes to Techsploration alumnae.
- 2. Applicants must be entering into a defined trades, business, or technology program at NSCC related to Shipbuilding.
- 3. Applicants are encouraged to explore the possibility of a work placement with Irving Shipbuilding and/or applying for a position after graduation.

## What are the criteria?

Scholarship applications will be evaluated on a combination of community engagement and a written essay.

## How do you apply?

Students must complete the application form found below and include a one-page essay, which can be attached at the end of this form. The essay should include, but not be limited to, the following information:

- 1. Describe the impact that Techsploration has had on you and/or your school.
- 2. Describe what made you choose the NSCC program for which you have been accepted.
- 3. Describe any community, leadership, volunteer, or employment activities in which you might be involved.

## Applicants must also submit:

- 1. A transcript of your academic record.
- 2. A letter of reference (preferably from an employer, volunteer organization, or a community member/leader) to briefly state your merits to receive the scholarship. Endorsements from a parent/guardian or a teacher who has helped with the Techsploration program cannot be used.
- 3. Acceptance letter from NSCC.



### What is the value?

The scholarship is valued at \$3,500. The award will be applied directly to a student's tuition in one installment in September.

### When is the deadline?

Applications must be received by the Scholarship Committee by August 15th, 2023 at 11:59 PM

Incomplete applications will not be considered. Only successful candidates will be notified. Note: This award is not transferable.
